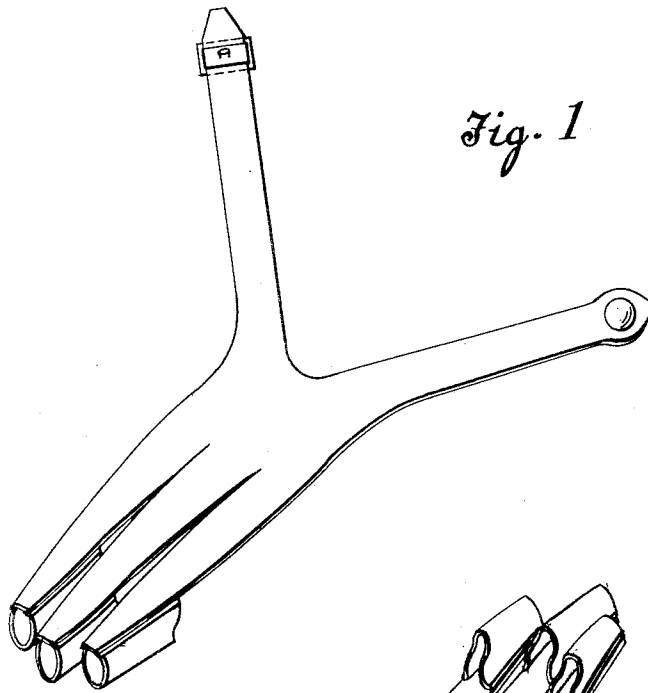

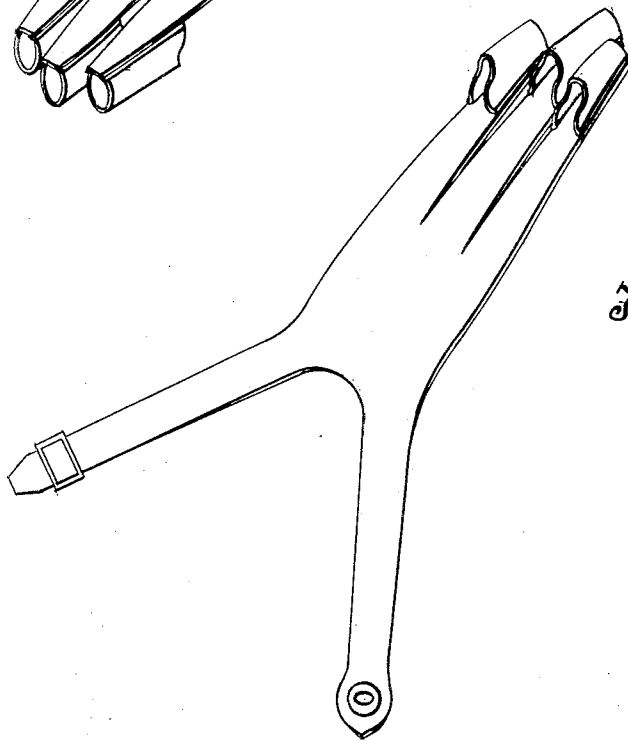

DESIGN FOR AN ARCHER'S GLOVE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Fred B. Bear, a citizen of the United States, residing at Detroit, in the county of Wayne and State of Michigan, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Archers' Gloves, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, wherein:

Fig. 1 is a perspective view of the glove, showing its outer face.

Fig. 2 is a perspective view, showing the inner face of the glove.
